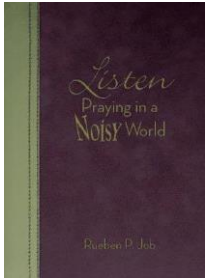


## **Lenten Studies Groups are here!**

## **Michigan Concert Choir Presents The Prodigal Son, March 25 7:00 pm**

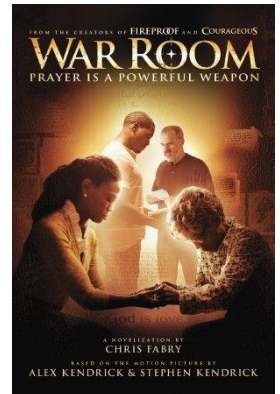
