WAVE Project Mobile Showers coming to our church

The WAVE Project brings mobile showers to people experiencing homelessness in our community and they are bringing those showers to Royal Oak First each Sunday in November. Produce Collection for Redford Brightmoor

During the pandemic, we have not stopped donating fresh produce to our friends at Redford Brightmoor Initiative once a month. RBI still serves about 50 families per week at their curbside Free Store each Saturday. On the second Friday of each month, four of us each purchase enough produce to create 13 assorted bags of items to donate. (You will be reimbursed for your expenses). One of us drives the 52 pre-assembled bags of produce down to RBI on Saturday morning by 8am.
