This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost is one of my favorite days of the Church year. I love Pentecost because it is a reminder of the greatest gift God has given us - the gift of the Holy Spirit!

The Holy Spirit is the living, active presence of God among us. The Holy Spirit animated the life, teachings, death and resurrection of Jesus. And on Pentecost, we declare that the same Holy Spirit that was in Jesus, the same Holy Spirit that raised him from the dead, that Holy Spirit also resides in you and in me!

Let that sink in: You have the Spirit of Jesus living in you - living in us!
