



This year, we're kicking off our Winter Toilet Paper Collection, and we're determined to earn the esteemed title of the "Toilet Paper Church!" (Yes, I can hear the chuckles already!)

Over the past year and a half, we have been proud to provide a non-food Essentials Pantry on the first Saturday of each month. From soap to toothpaste, cleaning supplies to feminine hygiene products, and yes, plenty of paper products, we have been blessed to share God's grace in tangible ways to over 60 families. In fact, we're rolling out over 200 rolls of toilet paper each month to ensure that our friends and neighbors have access to life's basic needs.
